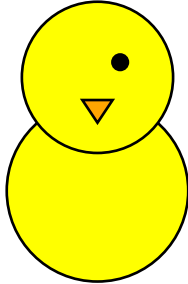


About Your Eggucation Hatching Experience

At the beginning of your pre-booked 10-day hire period, we will arrive at your school or nursery to set up all of the equipment and talk you through everything you need to know.

Within a few days, chicks, ducklings or partridges will hatch and can then be transferred from the incubator into the brooding unit.

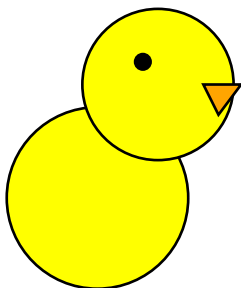


Once in the brooder, the birds can be observed and gently handled under adult supervision. We recommend that a responsible adult takes the birds home over the weekend unless someone is available on site to care for them.

At the end of the hire period, we will return to collect all equipment, along with any birds you wish to sign over if no suitable home is available. We provide a rehoming suitability guide to support safe, responsible placement.

Animal Welfare & Rehoming

We operate responsibly and ethically. All birds will be collected at the end of the hire period and returned to the farm. Occasionally, if a suitable home is available, we may transfer ownership or responsibly rehome birds. Please be assured that no birds will ever be destroyed.

Young birds grow quickly and require correct housing, ongoing care, and long-term commitment. We provide a rehoming suitability checklist to help you assess whether any third party can offer an appropriate home. The final decision will rest with the customer.
